RESOLVE Authorizing the Trustees of the Town of Houlton School District to Convey Certain Land to the Inhabitants of the Town of Houlton.

Trustees of Town of Houlton School District authorized to convey land. Resolved: That the Trustees of the Town of Houlton School District be, and hereby are, authorized to convey such parts of the Bird farm, so called, in the town of Houlton, as they deem unnecessary for school district purposes, to the inhabitants of the town of Houlton.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Bird farm, a tract of land in the town of Houlton, was acquired by the trustees of the Town of Houlton School District for school district purposes, but it is now found that the whole tract is not now needed by the district and this resolve is for the purpose of authorizing the return to the town of Houlton of the part not needed by the district.
