STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Closed Time on Deer in Southern Counties of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 82, amended. The 1st sentence of section 82 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows: 'There shall be an annual open season on deer during the month of from November 15th to December 15th, inclusive, in each calendar year in the counties of Androscoggin, Cumberland, Hancock, Kennebec, Knox, Lincoln, Sagadahoc, Waldo, Washington, York and that portion of Oxford county south of route 302.'
