RESOLVE Providing for a Fish Screen at Worthley Pond, in the Town of Peru, Oxford County.

Worthley pond; screening of. Resolved: That the sum of \$500 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game, for installing a fish screen at the outlet of Worthley pond in the town of Peru, Oxford county; provided, however, that the North Eastern Oxford County Fish and Game Protective Association shall assume all liability for maintaining said screen and keeping said screen free from all sticks, leaves and debris so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of water through the same; and provided further, that the state shall be liable for only ½ the cost of said screen.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

A screen was built in 1931 for which the state paid \$130 as its share. This screen has been washed out and fish escape down the river. It is desired to build a new screen.
