RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys for Repair of Fish Screen at Flying Pond, in the Town of Mount Vernon.

Repair of fish screen at Flying Pond. Resolved: That the sum of \$250 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game, for the repair of the fish screen at Flying Pond in the town of Mount Vernon, Kennebec county; provided, however, that the state shall be liable for only $\frac{1}{2}$ the cost of said screen.
