RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Crosby Pond, Coburn Gore, Franklin County.

Opening Crosby pond, Coburn gore, for trolling. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to open Crosby pond, in Coburn gore, county of Franklin, for trolling with anything for bait except fish, with a daily bag limit of 6 fish or 4 pounds, per person.
