RESOLVE Establishing Limit of Catch of Fish in Certain Dead River
Waters in Franklin County.

Daily bag limit in certain Dead river waters. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing a daily bag limit of 6 fish or 4 pounds, per person, on all Dead river waters flowing directly or indirectly into Flagstaff lake; Tim pond exempted.
