STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Uniforms for Members of Police Department of the City of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XI, § 7-A, additional. Article XI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939 is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, to be numbered 7-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 7-A. Uniforms for members. The city shall supply male members of the police department with necesary uniforms, but shall not expend more than \$100 per member annually.'
