RESOLVE Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Interest of the State in the Island in Cumberland County to H. Norman Cole, of Gray.

Authorizing forest commissioner to convey certain land. Resolved: That the Forest Commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to convey the interest of the state of Maine in, and to, a certain island in Notched pond, in the town of Gray, in the county of Cumberland, it being the only island in said pond, to H. Norman Cole, of said Gray, upon payment to the treasurer of state of the sum of \$50.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This island is about $\frac{1}{4}$ acre in area and is about 500 feet from the easterly shore of the pond which is a great pond. No record can be found of its conveyance by the state to any person and it has never been occupied by anyone.
