RESOLVE, Designating Bridge at Burnham as Burnham Memorial Bridge.

Burnham Memorial Bridge, designated. Resolved: That the bridge located at Burnham, county of Waldo, and being known as Burnham Village Bridge be hereafter officially named and referred to as Burnham Memorial Bridge.
