IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Regulating the Taking of Togue in Cold Stream Pond, Penobscot County.

Togue fishing in Cold Stream pond; regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation prohibiting the taking of lake trout, or togue, by plug or still fishing in Cold Stream pond or Cold Stream lake, in the towns of Lincoln, Enfield and Lowell, in the county of Penobscot.
