### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Lot contains 79.5 acres, of which 37.6 acres has been burned over and has grown to alders and bushes. There is 4.8 acres of poplar growth in the southwest corner from 4" to 8" DBH, and 32.1 acres of spruce, fir, and tamarack on the north half of the lot from 2" to 6" DBH. The soil is very thin and rocky making it almost useless for farm land.
