AN ACT Relating to Maintaining Roads to Shores of Lakes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 84, § 29, amended. Section 29 of chapter 84 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

'Provided, however, that ways leading from a public road to the shore of a lake laid out and used by 2 or more persons or corporations owning property on said shore, duly assessed for taxing purposes by the town wherein it lies, shall be maintained and kept in repair from May 1st to September 1st of each year by said town, notwithstanding other provisions of this chapter relating to acceptance of such ways by said towns.'
