RESOLVE in Favor of Caswell Plantation.

Caswell plantation; money reallocated. Resolved: That the money appropriated in favor of Caswell plantation, by the 93rd and 94th legislatures for the repair of the Richardson road, so called; work to begin where work ended under previous special resolve be, and hereby is, reappropriated to be expended during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1952, as follows: To aid in repairing the Griffin road, so called, work to begin at the intersection of the Griffin road with the Willard road and extending in a northerly direction.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This road leads to a large farm owned by Frolich and Wick and it is presently in very poor repair. The town of Caswell does not have funds to keep it in repair.
