AN ACT Relating to the Operation of Trucks During the Months of
December, January and February.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 18, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 18 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘Provided, however, that trucks for the registration of which a fee of \$100 or more has been paid, may be operated on the highways during the ~~month~~ ~~months~~ of December, ~~of the year in which such fee has been paid,~~ and during the ~~months~~ of January and February ~~of the year immediately following~~ with any overload; providing it is not in excess of the requirements of section 100.’
