STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Bulldozing of Streams.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 128, § 12-A, additional. Chapter 128 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 12-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 12-A. Bulldozing of rivers, streams and brooks. The bulldozing of a river, stream or brook in unorganized territory in excess of 25 feet within such river, stream or brook so that the natural flowage of such river, stream or brook is changed or hindered in any way shall be deemed a nuisance, unless permission is first obtained from the commissioner of inland fisheries and game.'
