IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Permitting the Building of a Wharf in Maranacook Lake.

Building of wharf permitted. Resolved: That Lawrence H. Foster, his associates, heirs and assigns are hereby authorized and empowered to construct, maintain and control a boathouse and wharf in the waters of Lake Maranacook, in the town of Winthrop, the same to be located at some point within 75 feet north from the north side of the bridge across Mill stream, so called, on Bowdoin street and adjacent thereto. In no case shall the wharf extend more than 50 feet into the lake from the high water mark.
