STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Salary of Justices of the Supreme Judicial and Superior Courts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 91, § 4, amended. The 1st sentence of section 4 of chapter 91 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The justices of the supreme judicial court shall each receive an annual salary of \$10,000 \$11,000, and the chief justice of the supreme judicial court shall receive an annual salary of \$11,000 \$12,000.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 94, § 2, amended. The 1st sentence of section 2 of chapter 94 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Each of the justices of the superior court shall receive an annual salary of \$9,500 \$10,500.'

Sec. 3. Limitation. No increases in salaries hereinbefore authorized shall be included in the annual salaries upon which deferred compensation payable under the provisions of section 5 of chapter 91 and section 3 of chapter 94 of the revised statutes shall be computed.
