SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1662, L. D. 1231, Bill "An Act  
to Incorporate the "Paris Company." "

Amend said Bill by striking out all of Section 5 thereof and  
inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 5. Subject to supervision. The corporation shall be  
subject to supervision of the bank commissioner and he shall have  
the same authority over it as he has over savings banks, trust  
companies and loan and building associations, and should said  
corporation apply for and receive a license to engage in the  
insurance business, then said corporation shall be subject to  
supervision of the insurance commissioner.'
