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**AN ACT Relating to the Trustees of the University of Maine.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1865, c. 532, § 4, repealed and replaced.** Section 4 of chapter 532 of the private and special laws of 1865 is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

‘Sec. 4. Trustees; number; state commissioner of education ex officio member. The state commissioner of education shall be ex officio a member of the board of trustees of the University of Maine with all the powers and privileges of members, and the number of trustees, including said ex officio member, is hereby increased to 11, of whom 2 shall be women. One of the women members shall be an alumna of the University of Maine, who shall be appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the council upon nomination by the Alumni Association of said university. The alumna member so nominated and appointed shall serve for a term of 3 years. The second woman member shall be appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the council for a term of 7 years.’
