STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Powers of Attorney General.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 17, § 9, amended. Section 9 of chapter 17 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:

'He may also, whenever in his judgment the public interest so requires, act in place of the county attorney, and he is invested with all the rights, powers and privileges of the county attorney, for that purpose, the powers of the county attorney being suspended therein.'
