STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Motor Vehicle Excise Taxes of Persons in Unorganized Territory.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 15-B, additional. Chapter 79 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 15-B, to read as follows:

'Sec. 15-B. County commissioners may adjust certain motor vehicle excise taxes. The county commissioners may cancel or adjust debts due from towns in their respective counties for motor vehicle excise taxes received from persons residing in unorganized territory.'
