

## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 95th LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1685, L. D. 1260, Bill "An Act Relating to the Taking of Clams and Quahogs in the Town of Brunswick".

Amend the title of said bill by striking out all after the word "Relating" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'to Taking of and Dealing in Clams, Quahogs, and Marine Worms in the Town of Brunswick'.

Further amend said bill by striking out in the paragraph beginning "<u>Sec. 88-E</u>" the underlined figure and letter "<u>88-G</u>" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure and letter 188-H:

Further amend said bill by inserting before the paragraph beginning "Sec. 88-F" the following underlined paragraph:

'Sec. 88-F. Dealers' licenses required; definition. No person shall be a dealer in clams, quahogs, clam-worms or blood-worms in the town of Brunswick without having first obtained a license from the municipal officers of said town, who are authorized to issue such license and fix the fee therefor. For the purpose of sections 88-E to 88-H, inclusive, the term "dealer" herein used shall mean any person, firm or corporation buying clams, quahogs, clam-worms or blood-worms for resale.'

Further amend said bill by renumbering Sections 88-F and 88-G to be 88-G and 88-H.
