IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Amending the Gasoline Road Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 14, § 185-L, amended. Section 185-L of chapter 14 of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 362 of the public laws of 1947 and reallocated by section 13 of chapter 349 of the public laws of 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 185-L. Application to certain carriers. The provisions of sections 244 to 256 185-A to 185-L, inclusive, shall also include motor vehicles, including trucks, tractors and semi-trailers or any combination thereof, not operated as common and contract carriers and which are licensed for a load of in excess of over \$\frac{1}{4000}\$ 20,000 pounds or for a gross weight of in excess of over \$\frac{10}{4000}\$ 20,000 pounds. Such vehicles shall not be required to secure a permit from the public utilities commission.'
