AN ACT Relating to the Alumni Trustee of the University of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1883, c. 196, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 196 of the public laws of 1883 is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 1. Alumni trustee; qualifications; tenure. One member of the board of trustees of the University of Maine shall be a graduate of said university, not less than 25 years of age, who shall hold his office for a term of 3 years and shall not necessarily be a legal resident of the state of Maine.'
