HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to H. P. 1695, L. D. 1273, Bill "An Act Imposing
a Sales and Use Tax."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end of the 7th paragraph of
section 2 thereof, which defines "Retail sale" or "sale at retail",
the following underlined sentence:

'Retail sale" or "sale at retail" do not include the sale of items
such as cans or bottles, together with labels affixed thereto,
actually accompanying the product sold to the final buyer or
ultimate consumer without which the delivery of the product is
impracticable on account of the character of the contents.'
