SENATE AMENDMENT "H" to H. P. 1695, L. D. 1273, Bill "An Act
Imposing a Sales and Use Tax."

Amend said Bill by adding to the 2nd paragraph of that part
designated "Sec. 3", the following underlined sentence:

'No tax shall be imposed on water stored for the purpose of
generating electricity when the water so stored is sold by a
subsidiary to its parent company.'
