SENATE AMENDMENT "I" to H. P. 1695, L. D. 1273, Bill "An Act
Imposing a Sales and Use Tax."

Amend said Bill by adding to that part designated "Sec. 10"
a new subsection to read as follows:

'VII-A. Coal, oil and wood. Coal, oil, wood and all other
fuels, except gas and electricity, used for cooking or heating for
domestic purposes.'
