HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 1696, L. D. 1276, Bill "An Act
Relating to Licenses to Hunt and Fish for
Members of the Armed Services of the United
States."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause the
following emergency preamble:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, there are members of the armed
forces of the United States of America stationed at military and
naval posts and bases within the state; and

Whereas, there are no provisions of law permitting such
members to purchase licenses to hunt and fish at the resident
license fee; and

Whereas, in order to permit such members to fish this spring
it is vitally necessary that the following legislation become
effective as soon as possible; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health
and safety; now, therefore, '

Further amend said Bill by striking out the 1st underlined
sentence of that part designated "XI" and inserting in place
thereof the following underlined sentence:

'A license to hunt or fish shall be issued, at the resident license
fee, to any member of the armed forces of the United States of
America who is a citizen of the United States and stationed at
some military or naval post, station or base within the state.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the
following emergency clause:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.'
