STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Westmanland Plantation.

Westmanland plantation; appropriation for. Resolved: That the sums appropriated in favor of Westmanland plantation by the 93rd and 94th legislatures to repair the Stockholm road, so called, be, and hereby is, reappropriated to be expended in repairing the Espling road, so called, beginning 3/4 of a mile from the end of state aid road #1 in a southerly direction and extending in an easterly direction to the New Sweden town line.
