STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relative to Fishing Contests.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 44-A, additional. Chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 44-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 44-A. Fishing contests. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, partnership, group of persons, association or corporation whose principal and usual activity is the conduct of mercantile, commercial or industrial business for private gain, to conduct a fishing contest wherein entry fees are accepted and prizes offered.'
