#### STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Waterford Fish and Game Association.

Waterford Fish and Game Association; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$180 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game, for installing a fish screen at the mouth of Bear pond in the town of Waterford in the county of Oxford; provided, however, that the Waterford Fish and Game Association shall assume all liability for the keeping of said screen at all times free from sticks, leaves and all debris, so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of water through the same; and provided further, that the state shall be liable for only ½ the cost of said screen.
