STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Authorizing Maine General Hospital to Convey Certain Lands to Maine Medical Center.

Maine General Hospital to convey certain lands. Resolved: That Maine General Hospital be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Maine Medical Center, a Maine corporation, all or any part of the lot of land with the buildings thereon, situated on Bramhall's Hill in the city of Portland, being the former site of the State Arsenal, conveyed to it by the state of Maine by chapter 180 of the resolves of the State of Maine, 1870, on condition that such land shall be used by Maine Medical Center for hospital purposes and that when such land ceases to be so used, it shall revert to the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

There is pending a project for joining the Maine General Hospital, the Maine Eye & Ear Infirmary and the Children's Hospital, all located in Portland, in one unit, Maine Medical Center, so as to integrate these hospital services. This resolve will enable Maine General Hospital to join in such plan.
