HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 1734,

L. D. 1293, Bill "An Act to Provide Facilities
for the Peaceful Settlement of Industrial
Disputes Through Mediation."

Amend said Amendment by adding at the end thereof before the period the underlined words and punctuation:

but excluding cases involving firemen, policemen, school teachers, or other employees of the state, its subdivisions, and municipalities!

So that said amendment as amended shall read as follows:

"Amend said Bill by striking out section 2 thereof and inserting in place thereof the following section:

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 25, §10, amended. The 7th sentence of section 10 of chapter 25 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following words:

'and to have authority to settle questions relating to the determination of a bargaining agent in cases of the employment of more than 10 employees by one employer, but excluding cases involving firemen, policemen, school teachers, or other employees of the state, its subdivisions, and municipalities.'"
