RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Birch River.

Fishing in Birch river, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing to all fishing the tributaries of Birch river, in the county of Aroostook.
