STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Prohibiting Claims of Damage to Motor Vehicles by Wild Animals and Birds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 3, § 84-A, repealed and replaced. Section 84-A of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:
- 'Sec. 84-A. No payments for motor vehicle damage. No claim for damages to motor vehicles by a protected wild animal or wild bird shall be paid by the state.'
- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 33, § 84-B, repealed. Section 84-B of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby repealed.
