IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Dealers in Bait.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 55, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 55 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'All persons dealing in live bait shall be licensed to do so by the commissioner, and the fee therefor shall be \$2 \$5 for each calendar year. The license shall authorize the person holding the same to use the ordinary commercial type of minnow trap or the ordinary commercial type of minnow seine not to exceed 4 feet in depth by 25 feet in length, in the taking of minnows and other unprotected fish commonly used for bait purposes.'
