SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1762, L. D. 1306, Bill "An Act
Relating the Polling Place in Rockwood in
Somerset County."

Amend said Bill by striking out Section 2 thereof and in-
serting in place thereof the following section:

"Sec. 2. R. S., c. 14, §101-A, amended. Section 101-A of
chapter 14 of the revised statutes, as enacted by section 5 of
chapter 349 of the public laws of 1949, is hereby amended by in-
serting before the last paragraph thereof a new paragraph to read
as follows:

'Poll-taxes collected by the state tax assessor from the
residents of Rockwood in the year in which the biennial state
election is held shall be paid by the state to Jackman plantation,
provided the state tax assessor receives from the officials of
Jackman plantation a request therefor by June 1st of the following
year.'"
