RESOLVE, Permitting the Building of a Wharf in Maranacook Lake.

Building of wharf permitted. Resolved: That Laurence H. Foster, his associates, heirs and assigns are hereby authorized and empowered to construct, maintain and control a wharf in the waters of Lake Maranacook, in the town of Winthrop, the same to be located at some point within 75 feet north from the north side of the bridge across Mill stream, so called, on Bowdoin street and adjacent thereto. In no case shall the wharf extend more than 25 feet into the lake from the high water mark, provided, however, that if it is attached to town property he shall first obtain the approval of the voters of the town of Winthrop at a special or annual town meeting within 2 years from the effective date of this resolve.
