HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1782, L. D. 1320, Resolve, Proposing
an Amendment to the Constitution to Clarify
the Provisions That Relate to the State's
Borrowing Power.

Amend said Resolve by striking out the title thereof, and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'Resolve Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution to
Clarify the Provisions Relating to Borrowing Power of the State,
and to Place a Limit of \$10,000,000 on the Right of the Legis-
lature to Borrow'

Further amend said Resolve by inserting after the word "power"
in the 11th line of that part of the Resolve designated "Form of
question and date when amendment shall be voted upon." the
following:

', and to place a limit of \$10,000,000 on the right of the
legislature to borrow without a vote of the people'.
