STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Oscar Pinette, of Portland.

World War I bonus granted to Oscar Pinette. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated \$100 to be paid to Oscar Pinette, of Portland, as his World War I bonus; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Every honorably discharged veteran of World War I was voted a state bonus of \$100 if application was made by a certain date. Mr. Pinette did not make his application before the specified date and he is now requesting that it be paid to him. Oscar Pinette, then of Biddeford, was inducted into the U. S. Navy April 17, 1917 with Serial Number 1532829.
