RESOLVE, in Favor of Leo Smith, of Pittsfield.

Leo Smith; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$496.25 to be paid to Leo Smith, of Pittsfield, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for chickens killed by foxes; said sum to be paid from the dog tax fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This loss was reported by Mr. Smith to the selectmen of Pittsfield on September 23, 1950 and the department of animal husbandry received notice on October 10, 1950. Three hundred ninety-seven chickens were destroyed, valued at \$1.25 each.
