IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Percy E. Severance, of Hampden, for Taxes, Etc.

Percy E. Severance; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the state the sum of \$178.23 to be paid to Percy E. Severance, of Hampden, for taxes for the year 1933, with interest, lien fees and costs on property purchased from the state, originally known as the Arthur L. Thayer property in Charleston.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

At the time this property was purchased, the Farm Lands Loan Commission (a state agency at that time) agreed by letter from the commission to protect Mr. Severance from payment of this tax, but through some neglect failed to do so.
