RESOLVE, to Reimburse Freeport Grain Company for Damage Done by Escapee.

Freeport Grain Company; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$106 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund to be paid to Freeport Grain Company, of Freeport, as a full and final settlement of its claim against the state for damage to grain and other stock by an escapee from the Pownal state school.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

An inmate of the Pownal state school escaped and while at large did damage to the extent of \$106 to the stock of the Freeport Grain Company.

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
