RESOLVE, in Favor of Dwight D. Dixon, of Clinton.

Dwight D. Dixon; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$67.50 to be paid to Dwight D. Dixon, of Clinton, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for 45 hens killed by foxes; said sum to be paid from the dog tax fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Dixon lost 90 hens during July and August of 1950. He has been paid for loss of 45 hens by the department of agriculture but was denied payment for the other 45 hens because of lack of sufficient evidence at that time. Since then there has been new evidence to substantiate the claim.
