RESOLVE, in Favor of Allagash Plantation.

Allagash plantation; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$660 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to Allagash plantation, to reimburse said plantation for cutting and burning bushes along the roadside from St. Francis through Allagash plantation for a distance of approximately 11 miles; said sum to be paid from the general highway fund of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The state supervisor failed to get his pay rolls in on time. It was suggested by the department that a resolve was the only way for Allagash plantation to be reimbursed.
