**RESOLVE, in Favor of Folsom Brothers of Monticello.**

---

**Folsom Brothers; compensated. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$1,045 to be paid to the Folsom Brothers, of Monticello, as a full and final settlement for their claim against the state for lambs and sheep killed by unknown animals; said sum to be paid from the dog tax fund.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Fifty lambs, valued at \$20 each, and 3 sheep, valued at \$15 each, were killed June 22, 1949 by unknown animals. The damage was reported to the town manager on June 23, 1949.
