STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Providing for State Pension for Mrs. Minnie Fenderson, of Saco.

Teacher's pension granted to Mrs. Minnie Fenderson, of Saco. Resolved: That a special pension be, and hereby is, granted to Mrs. Minnie Fenderson, of Saco, comparable with that paid under the teachers' noncontributory pension law, based on 25 years of teaching service, as is now or may hereafter be provided by the legislature, to be paid quarterly from the appropriation for pensions for retired teachers. Such pension shall begin on July 1, 1951 and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mrs. Fenderson is approximately 80 years old. She is in poor health and has no one to assist her financially. She has a daughter who is dependent on her.
