SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1786, L. D. 1346, Bill "An Act
Relating to the Liquor Commission."

Amend said Bill by striking out section 1 thereof and
inserting in place thereof the following:

"R. S., c. 57, §6, sub-§IV-A, additional. Section 6 of
chapter 57 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further
amended by adding thereto a new subsection, to be numbered IV-A,
to read as follows:

'IV-A. The commission at all times and with respect to
all policies shall neither discriminate against nor in favor of
any person, firm or corporation because of his residence or non-
residence in the state except as provided for in subsection IV of
this section.'"

Further amend said Bill by striking out section 2 thereof.
