## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Robert George Llewellyn, of South Portland.

Robert George Llewellyn; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$316 from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game and to be paid to Robert George Llewellyn, of South Portland, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car which was taken by an escapee from the state school for boys.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Llewellyn's car was stolen on January 7, 1951 by Lewis Green who had escaped from the state school for boys at South Portland. It was later recovered at Bangor. The car had been run off the road and damaged to the extend of \$316.
