STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Peter Spanos, of Portland.

Peter Spanos; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$104.70 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game to Peter Spanos, of Portland, to reimburse him for money collected by the Western Oxford Municipal court on October 26, 1949 for violation of an inland fisheries and game law.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This was one of 10 different individuals who was apprehended while hunting a closed area in Oxford county which had not been posted. Eight of the 10 cases were nol prossed and no moneys paid, but in this case he paid a fine and costs of \$104.70, which should have been returned when the case was nol prossed, but was not.
